

THE FORTY-YEAR PLAN

How long does it take to fundamentally change the thinking of a large group of people and get them to adopt and embrace new ways of thinking and acting? It took forty years for the Children of Israel to transition from a slavery mentality to being a powerful group capable of taking over, occupying and controlling a land that was inhabited and ruled by “giants” as described in Numbers 13:33. There was a cataclysmic event (being freed from Egyptian slavery) that initiated the transition that took four decades (a generation) to bring about the circumstances and conditions for implementation of the agenda described in God’s covenant with Abraham four centuries before that time.

Fourteen centuries later there was another cataclysmic event that unfolded on the stage of history that was a fulfillment of the means by which the objective of God’s agenda was initiated. That objective was for all the nations of the earth to be blessed by the “seed” of Abraham (Gen 22:18). This event was the crucifixion of the Messiah which marked the end (completion) of the Abrahamic covenant and the beginning of a New Covenant that was ratified by the shed blood (death) of God Incarnate to redeem all of humanity from slavery to the “world, the flesh and the devil.” Paul affirmed this in Col 1:20 where we read “And God purposed through Him to reconcile the [all things or universe] to Himself, making peace through His blood, which was shed upon the Cross—to reconcile to Himself through Him, I say, things on earth and things in Heaven.” Again, it took forty years (from the time of the crucifixion) for the “generation change” to take place which was marked by the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple and by the fact that the good news of this fundamental change in the way God was dealing with humanity could be spread throughout the region that made up their world. Paul also affirmed this fulfillment in his statement in the latter part of Col 1:23 “your hope that rests on the Good News that you have heard, which has been proclaimed in the whole creation under Heaven, and in which I Paul have been appointed to serve.”

Over the past several decades, we have heard about efforts to “fundamentally change” various ways we function as humanity. Various terms have emerged that seem to be related to the “change” agenda. One of the terms that most of us have heard is “New World Order” and the “Great Reset” which is targeted to be initiated or implemented by what is described in United Nations Agenda 21 (in reference to the 21st Century) and Agenda 2030 which is the target date for implementation.

If we back up forty years from 2030, it brings us to 1990. What happened around that time that might have been the initiation of this transformation? It is helpful to realize that the new world order’s plans are based on crisis management, and the idea that a great crisis will occur that will lead to the great transition, where globalists will swoop in to save the day, transforming society into the promised utopian paradise. For many years, the crisis was the “Cold War.” However, evidence of the dissolution of the USSR began in November 1989 which eliminated the “crisis” we called the Cold War. So, a new crisis was needed to provide a plausible excuse for the globalization agenda.

The alternative plan was moved toward finalization in 1990 and was made public in 1991 in a Club of Rome meeting. (The Club of Rome was a “think tank” with early connection to the World Economic Forum.) This plan was stated (by the Club of Rome) to be “a new justification for this all-powerful state.” Their own publication titled *The First Global Revolution*, stated “In searching for a common enemy to unite us, we came up with the idea that pollution, the threat of global warming, water shortages, famine, and the like, would fit the bill. And therefore, the real enemy is humanity itself.”

We could ask ourselves, is there an obvious connection between the items in the “common enemies” list with what is happening today in the attempt to tie everything “bad” that happens to “global warming?” In fact, “global warming” is claimed to be the cause of all the other items in the list of “common enemies.”
